Internal Assessment (IA) for BA/BSc 1st/3rd/5th Semester Examination 2019

This is for information of all concerned that Internal Assessment (IA) for BA/BSc 1st Semester Examination, 2019 in all subjects will be done according to the newly implemented CBCS guidelines. However, Internal Assessment for the 3rd/5th Semester Examination, 2019 will be done according to the earlier practice. Sessional Examination for the 1st/3rd/ 5th Semester classes will start from 16.09.2019.

In the CBCS, 20 marks have been allotted for IA in a paper. The following scheme of awarding marks has been suggested for IA:

Written Sessional Examination*	Attendance**	Home Assignment/ Seminar/ Group discussion/ Field study	Total

*As per CBCS guidelines, Written Sessional Examination will be conducted for 30 Marks for the convenience of setting questions and covering the syllabus. Marks secured by the students will be proportionately converted to 'out of 10' marks. Duration of examination will be of one hour.

**The following criteria will be adopted for awarding marks in the category of attendance:

- (a) Class attendance from 76% to 80% - 1 Mark
- (b) Class attendance from 81% to 85% - 2 Marks
- (c) Class attendance from 86% to 90% - 3 Marks
- (d) Class attendance from 91% to 100% - 4 Marks

All the departments are requested to arrange the question papers in consultation with college office. Question setter(s) should put the paper code for CBCS in the header as per Subject and Paper coding guidelines published by GU. Students are to be encouraged to write the paper code on the answer script.
